# Allotment Photo Competition Rules

1. The subject categories for the Allotment Committee photograph competition are:
  - a) **Best Colne Town Council Allotment Plot**
  - b) **Best New Plot.** To qualify for Best New Plot category, potholders must have signed their Allotment Agreement after the 31st May 2018 and have not previously won first place in a Colne Town Council Allotment competition. Ideally two photos should be submitted giving a before and after view of the plot.
  - c) **Best Young Gardener.** To qualify for the Best Young Gardener the entry must be for a person 12 years old or younger and having the consent of their parent or guardian and the plot holder, managed the planting and maintenance of the plot bed or planter on a Colne Town Council Allotment plot with assistance from the plot holder.
  - d) **Best Allotment Photo** (*People's Choice Award*)
2. Entrants may only submit one photo in each category. The photo must have been taken on a Colne Town Council Allotment anytime after the 1st October 2020 by the plot holder (*or a person authorised by them*).
4. If less than two entries are received in total for any of the individual award categories, that category will be withdrawn from this year's competition.
6. The competition is open to Colne Town Council Allotment Plot holders only. Councillors and employees of Colne Town Council as well as their immediate families are not eligible to enter. Entrants under the age of 12 years need to have their parent or guardian consent to enter.
8. Each entry must include:
  - the plot holders name, address and phone number
  - details of the date and plot on which the photo was taken.
  - The category for which the photo is being entered.
9. Entries should be emailed to: **allotments@colnetowncouncil.org.uk** by no later than midnight on Sunday 4<sup>th</sup> July 2021. The organisers accept no responsibility for entries delayed, lost, or corrupted.
10. All entries will be judged by the judging panel. The judges will select up to twelve photographs for the Best Allotment Photo category to go through to the public vote.
11. In the event of a technical problem or evidence of impropriety regarding the 'public' vote, the judges shall have the final decision. If the public vote results in a tie, the judges shall have the casting vote. The judges' decisions will be final, and no correspondence can be entered into.
12. All entries must be the original work of the entrant and must not infringe the rights of any other party or have breached any laws when taking their photographs. The entrants must be the sole owner of the copyright for photographs entered and must have obtained consent of all people featured. Written consent will be required from the parents/guardians of any children under 16 years of age in the photo.
13. Entries must not have been offered for sale, sold, published or entered into any other competition or publication.
14. By entering this competition, entrants agree to be bound by these rules and grant to Colne Town Council:
  - the right to publish and exhibit their photograph(s) on the Council's website, and social media pages and include them in any Colne Town Council related publicity or publication including calendars printed or digitally produced.
  - the right to exclude any entries which breached these rules.
15. If the winner is unable to be contacted after reasonable attempts have been made, Colne Town Council reserves the right to either offer the prize to a runner up or to re-offer the prize in a future competition.
16. Colne Town Council reserves the right to cancel or revise these rules at any stage.
17. These rules are governed by the laws of England and Wales. This competition is administered by the Colne Town Council.
