Unfortunately, there has been a significant amount of anti-social/criminal behaviour in the garden at the Primet Community Centre resulting first, in the smashing of the trellis and a week later the burning down of the Colne In Bloom shed. Although a number of gardening tools and equipment have been lost the summer barrier troughs and pole planters were being stored elsewhere. It is hoped that the security measures currently in place in the area are assessed.



As the summer planning season approaches and the muscari, daffodil and tulip bulbs fade the volunteers have been busy deadheading the daffodils and tulips. The Lengthsmen have taken all the barrier troughs to the C.I.B. polytunnel. The group have removed the hundreds of polyanthus and thousands of bulbs from the street planters; the railway station and from the nine existing flower towers as they prepare for the arrival of the summer plants.
